### Meefings of the Council

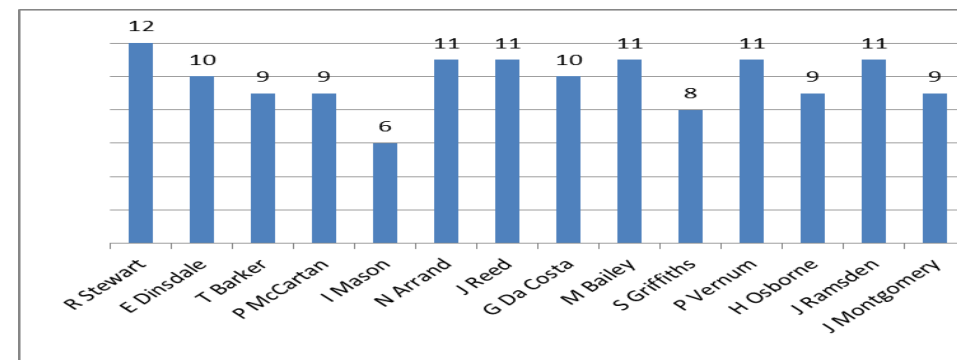
