PUBLIC NOTICE—CROWLE CEMETERY

We hereby give notice that we are going to undertake some maintenance of the graves within the cemetery. Some of our older graves have leaning headstones which need laying down for safety reasons. We are also intending to clear overgrown weeds from graves and remove broken loose stone edging where appropriate. We wish to improve the general appearance of the Cemetery so if any relatives wish to tend their family graves we hereby give notice that works will commence on **OCT 13th 2014**

The grounds in the Cemetery are cut fortnightly in the growing season and we undertake annual maintenance of path clearing and hedge trimming. We are also working on the Chapels, the Arch and Chapel Bell. After a recent survey some urgent items have been attended to but more intensive works need to be done. We will be tendering for these works and hope to start them in the New Year. We understand that this may cause some distress for families visiting their loved ones whilst workmen are around but we hope that you understand that they are essential and necessary improvements which will make the Cemetery more attractive.
