YC/043/23 Youth Mayors Report

- Members informed that all meetings of the Youth Council from Nov will now take place in The Chapels.

YC/044/23 Community Planting Area

A scheme of perennial shrub and bulb planting was suggested and agreed for passing onto the Community Hall for consideration at their next meeting. The areas will firstly need to be cleared and prepared for planting.

Option 1 includes the area on the left of the entrance as above

Option 2 includes the additional area of the section in front of the low wall

Option 3 includes all front and side beds.

The Community Hall have agreed to fund the costs of the plants.

Cllr J Reed suggests that a plaque be sited on completion of the project stating "Planted by C&ETC Youth Council" or words to that effect.
